Year 4	<p><u>Presenting Myself</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Understand and use set phrases to talk about themselves and ask others for simple information in return. -Count from 1-20 and use numbers out of sequence. -Identify pronunciation change depending on the speaker (girl or boy). 	<p><u>Family</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Say the nouns in Spanish for members of their family. -Give family members names and ages. -Count up to 100. -Understand the concept on 'mi' and 'mis'. 	<p><u>My Home</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Say whether they live in a house/apartments and say where it is. -Repeat, recognise and attempt to spell up to ten nouns (for the rooms of a house). -Tell and ask somebody what rooms they have/do not have in their home. 	<p><u>R.E - People</u></p> <p><u>RSE - Relationships</u></p> <p><u>Maths - Multiples of ten</u></p>
Year 5	<p><u>Do you have a pet?</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Repeat, recognise and attempt to spell the eight nouns for pets. -Tell and ask somebody if they have/do not have a pet. -Say their name of their pet. 	<p><u>The Weather</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Repeat and recognise the vocabulary for weather in Spanish. -Ask what the weather is like today. 	<p><u>Planets</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Name and recognise the planets on our solar system map. - Spell at least five of the planets. 	<p><u>Maths - Multiples of ten</u></p> <p><u>Science - Earth and Space</u></p> <p><u>Music - Journey into Space</u></p> <p><u>P.E - Flamenco Dancing</u></p>
