Parents were welcomed and were introduced to Andrea Bates (Senior Road Safety Officer)-Knowsley Council.

Andrea Bates talked parents through a Road Safety presentation. This covered:-

- Guide to parking enforcement in Knowsley
- Measures taken by Knowsley:- Traffic Calming

• How parents can help:-

-Children copy adults – please ensure that you are modelling safe crossing practices. -Hold onto their hand. It only takes a second for a child to become distracted and for a tragedy to occur.

-Park away from school and walk the last ten minutes of your journey. The parked cars outside school make it almost impossible for passing drivers to see young children who may be about to run into the road.

-Research has shown that children who walk the journey to school, or walk part of it, arrive at school more alert and ready for learning than those who have travelled by car.

- Also there are obvious health benefits of walking and getting fresh air and exercise.

Parents were given the opportunity to make comments and ask questions.

The parents in attendance were very appreciative of Andrea's input and were asked to share what they heard with all parents.
