

### Delegate for Catholic Social Action



Sr Lynne Baron, FCJ has been appointed as the Archbishop's delegate for this role. Sr Lynne will be a key member of the new Archbishop's Advisory Body and will ensure that the voice of a woman will be heard as the archdiocese makes important decisions. A key call

from the Synod was to renew our Church by reaching out, by being welcoming and inclusive. The Pastoral Plan called for a new role to "place at the forefront of life of the Church inclusivity, justice and peace, the poor, marginalised and the environment, recognising that concern for the environment is a core dimension of our evangelising mission in the world." Sr Lynne preached at St Margaret Mary's at Sunday Mass last month.
