Well done Oliver! This is a fantastic achievement!





Wrap Up Warm

As the Winter months are upon us and the weather is getting colder, we recommend that, in order to keep warm, the children wear extra layers for school under their school uniform. At this time, we are required to keep school well ventilated and this means that windows need to be opened.

Breakfast and After School Club
