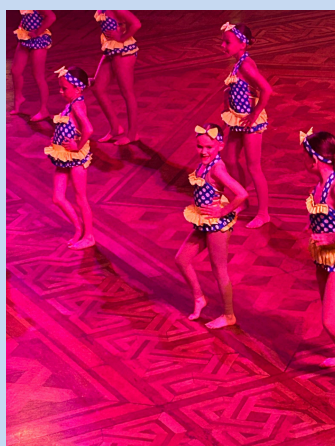
They had choreographed their own dance and had worked on this for weeks so that it was ready to be performed in front of a live audience who were very impressed with them.
