Congratulations to Isla for achieving Star of the week in gymnastics for amazing aerial skills.





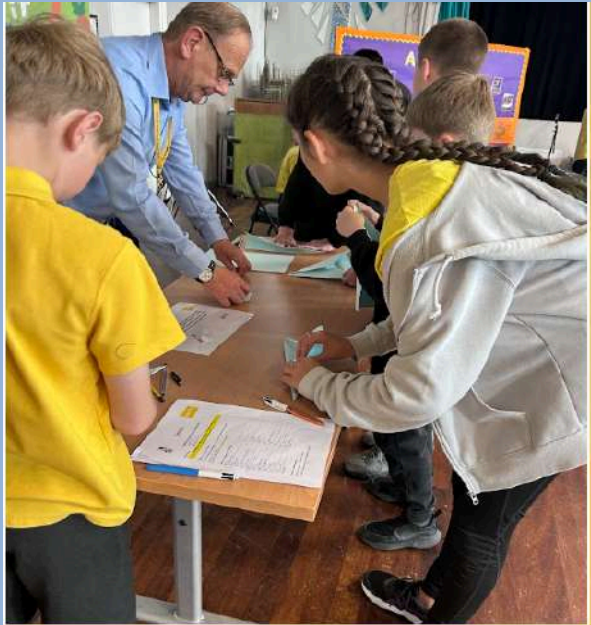
Congratulations to Gabriel for winning Parents Player of the season and to Callum who was awarded Manager's Player of the season. Well done!

PARENT FORUM

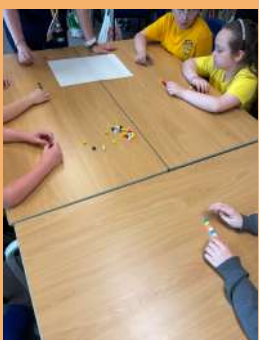
Our final Parent Forum of the year will take place next Tuesday (17th June) at 6pm
