#### Social Media

We would like to request that parents monitor their child's use of social media as we have recently been made aware of some inappropriate use of social media that has caused distress and has spilled over into school. Please note that for the majority of social media apps (Facebook, Instagram, Tiktok, Snapchat), users should be aged **13 years or over**. For Whats-App the required age is **16 years**.

As a school we would recommend that parents actively discourage their child from using any app with a recommended age of 12+.

#### **Book Fair**

The Book Fair will be arriving in School on **Wednesday 4th May**. At this time, parents/carers are unable to attend the Book Fair. Instead, each year group will be allocated a day when they can browse the Book Fair with their class and create a 'Wish List' of books that they particularly like. This 'Wish List' will then be brought home for parents to see. Parents can then make the decision as to whether to order any of the books listed. Attached to this email is a leaflet which shows some of the books available at the Book Fair.
